SAFETY RULES IN CASE OF EMERGENCY

- When settling in your plot or camping area, locate your location on the map and locate the nearest emergency exit fence as well as fire extinguishers.
- If you see any fire, immediately notify the campsite or reception staff, indicating as precisely as possible the scope and location of the fire. If necessary use the nearest fire extinguisher.
- When the campsite staff, firefighters or protection members attend, leave the initiative to them. • If you light a fire in a pan, do not use water; Cover it with a lid or very damp cloth.

In case someone is injured, do not move them.

- Do not use the car or caravan in case of evacuation. Go on foot to a clear place, where indicated or to the nearest emergency exit.

REMEMBER THE 112 EMERGENCY PHONE PREVENTIVE RULES

- Do not light barbecues on the ground or using branches or firewood. 85 of the trees. According to BOJA n^o of May 8, 2023, establishes the prohibition of any type of fire, including barbecue from May 8 to October 15.
If you have a fire extinguisher, have it handy when using your barbecue; If you don't have it, prepare a bucket of water next to the fire. Do not place fabrics or fabrics on ignition or heat sources.
Comply with the smoking ban in areas where indicated.
Do not throw cigarettes, butts or lit matches in trash cans, bags or floors, always use ashtrays
- Monitor the good condition of your camping gas cylinder and cooking equipment. Do not use domestic gas cylinders and never cook inside the tent.
- Do not overload the capacity of the electrical installation.
Its maximum power is 6 Amps (1300 w). Do not tamper with the power outlet box. Please inform reception of any anomaly you notice in the electrical connection.
- Do not use electrical appliances in showers.
In case of strong wind, secure the straps of your tent and refrain from making any type of fire.
- If you are staying at the campsite with children, be especially careful with sharp objects, medications, cleaning products and flammable products.
- Take special care when crossing the pedestrian crossing leading to the beach.
